THE HOPE STREETS PROJECT IS A MAJOR NATIONAL LOTTERY HERITAGE FUND-SUPPORTED INITIATIVE TO ENGAGE YOUNG PEOPLE IN THE HERITAGE OF THEIR LOCAL COMMUNITIES. IT SEEKS TO REVOLUTIONISE THE WAYS MUSEUMS CONNECT WITH YOUNG PEOPLE, AND LOOKS TO ENABLE THEM TO INFLUENCE THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF THE HERITAGE SECTOR.
