The Council of the Southport Palette Club are pleased to invite you to exhibit at our 96th Annual Art Exhibition, which is part of the Sefton Open Art Show to be held at The Atkinson from Saturday 9 April until Saturday 21 May 2022. Each artist is responsible for selecting original artwork for inclusion, which has not previously been exhibited in *The Sefton Open, Sefton Open Online, Palette Club By Invitation Landing Exhibition* or anywhere at The Atkinson. We welcome a wide variety of media including film, sculpture, craft, paintings and textiles. To submit work you must either live, work or have been educated in Sefton.

PEOPLE'S PRIZE

This is a showcase exhibition opportunity for artists with the chance to win a prize for the work that receives the greatest number of visitor's votes.

Entry Guidelines:

- 1. Artists may submit up to three original artworks for consideration by the Southport Palette Club. No more than 4 works can be submitted by any individual artist in the Sefton Open: this includes works with the Southport Palette Club and works displayed through groups and societies.
- 2. Small objects such as ceramics can be charged as one entry only if they fit within a space the size of a sheet of A4 paper. If they are larger, for example a group of bowls, then they should be entered separately.

- 3. All paintings, prints and drawings must be framed with mirror plates attached for display (see diagram). Work without mirror-plates or in a clip frame will not be accepted for consideration.
- 4. All works must be labelled with your name, the title and price of each piece or Not For Sale clearly written on the back (see diagram). Please ensure that all pictures are securely fixed to the frames.
- 5. A second hanging label showing these details should also be attached to the back but overhanging the front of your work. This label is used by us for identification once the piece has been hung.
- 6. Only original works will be accepted or copies that are clearly referenced in the image or through the title. All copies or influenced work must be clearly referenced.
- 7. The artist is responsible for packing their own works. No packing materials can be stored at The Atkinson.
- 8. The Atkinson will subtract a commission of 25% from the Sale Price you provide. The Southport Palette Club will subtract a commission of 5%. The total amount deducted from the artist will therefore be 30%. Please consider this when deciding your Sale Price. All sales must be made through The Atkinson.
- 9. It is the artist's sole responsibility to insure their work against any loss or damage.
- 10. There is a £5 non-refundable handling fee for each work submitted, payable on submission with your completed Entry Form.

Handing in day: Works can be submitted only on Tuesday 29th March 2022 between 11am and 7pm **Collection of unselected work before exhibition:** 11am – 4pm Thursday 31st March and Friday 1st April 2022. (Please note The Palette Club will not provide any explanation of unselected work) **Collection of unsold work at end of exhibition:** 12pm – 4pm Tuesday 24th May or 10am – 4pm

Wednesday 25th May and Thursday 26th May 2022.

* PLEASE NOTE: Unless The Atkinson is advised of problems collecting works on the dates stated any work not collected will incur a storage fee of £5 per day. If the artist does not contact The Atkinson to arrange a new collection date any uncollected artwork will be disposed of after seven days.
